In the 1960's – 1970's most schools had or were visited by a public health nurse that gave all children in the school an annual simple eye chart screening for visual acuity. For a number of years, this is no longer done in the schools and Lions' members have been visiting schools annually with our vision screening program for over 15 years to achieve greater awareness in the community for the visual needs of children

Lions Community volunteers assist in identifying young children who could have poor visual acuity. Statistics have indicated since our program has been introduced how surprised we are that so many children have never seen or had a comprehensive eye examination.
